Overview

Today we start our new workbook. In church and on zoom, we are skipping chapter 1, which covers the risen Jesus coming back to his disciples, and Thomas's hard time believing. It's a great story, but we have a limited number of weeks between now and Pentecost! We are moving to the next part of the story, when Jesus meets his disciples while they are fishing, and tells Peter a really important lesson. He asks Peter (three times!) to feed his sheep. Peter is charged (as are we all) with loving and caring for God's people.

• What do you see? Who do you think this is? Does he look friendly to you? What do you think he's doing? Who do you think the characters are in our story today? What clues do you see?

Read the story together, pages 18-19

Turn the page and study the comic, pg. 20-21

• Who can re-tell this story, or a piece of it, from this comic?
