Storymakers Lent Chapter 3: Lost and Found

Overview

Today we hear our third parable from Jesus. This week we get a hint that the religious leaders were not so happy with the attention Jesus was getting (this hint is important for the older children, who will wonder why Jesus was later arrested and crucified). This parable is about seeking things that are lost—precious things. Jesus is telling us that God loves every human SO much, God will always search for us, pursue us, seek us out.

What do you see? Who do you think this is? Who do you think the characters are in our story today? What clues do you see? Does the verse of page 27 give you more clues?

Read the story together, and study the comic on the following pages.

Can you re-tell this story, or a piece of it, from this comic? What are the important things Jesus was trying to tell us?

Our chapter continues on pages 32-35.

Let's remember that God is with us in all of our feelings. When we have big feelings, God is right here to help comfort us, or even just be with us.

In today's parable, Jesus is teaching us that God's love is humungous. God's love for us is greater than any kind of love. God is always trying to be close to us, no matter what.
